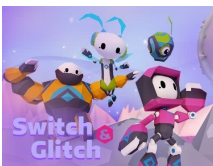

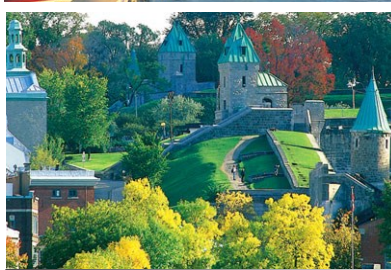

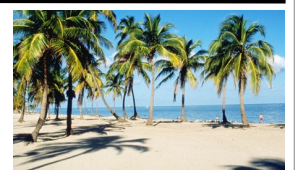

Subtopics covered include: Article 35 and NY laws pertaining to the use and carry of your Pistol, safe handling of a handgun in your home & on the range. This class is taught by Certified NRA Instructor, Cheryl Schenne. 3 hour course includes materials and a Certificate of Completion (*required for Erie, Niagara, Orleans & Genesee County Pistol Permit application process*). **Cost: \$60.00.
