ALL ABOUT CAMP

What's a Day Like at Camp? Our theme changes, so there are new exciting activities, programs, and events every week. (Check out the special features of each week in the detailed listing.) However, some things don't change because they are FUN everyday. After a morning gathering of all campers, the kids break off into their age appropriate groups. They will rotate through different areas of camp including sports, crafts, group activity, and special events. This year STEAM, yoga, dance, and culinary workshops will be included in each week.



Meals: Breakfast and Lunch are available at the Byron-Bergen High School Cafeteria at no cost to students, 18 and under, through the summer food program. Bagged Lunches are prepared for field trip days.

Camp T-Shirts: Campers receive a FREE Daycamp T-Shirt their first week of camp. The T-shirts are used for a special art project and should be worn for our weekly field trips.



Registration: Kids that have completed Kindergarten up to 6th grade are eligible for daycamp. Camp runs from 9am-3pm, Monday thru Friday. Our "home base" is the **Byron Bergen High School Cafeteria**. Kids can be dropped off and picked up at this location.
