
Day Trip to Vidler's 5 & 10 and Marilla Country Store Thursday, October 16th 9:30am-5:00pm

SWIMMING LESSONS—7 Week Session~Thursdays September 18, 25, October 2, 9, 23, 20, November 6 (no lessons October 16th) Fee: \$80 M/\$90 NM Register by September 11th

Class size is limited, register early. First come, first serve basis for preferred times.

Our Swim Lesson Coordinator is Sara Stockwell.

LESSON LEVELS: The teaching staff will be evaluating the skills of children during the first class and re-classify them if necessary. Re-classification may make it necessary for your child to move to a different session time. The coordinator, Ms. Stockwell can discuss options with you at this point.

SWIM BASICS 1:

Recommended for ages 3-5 years old

Class Time: 6:00pm-6:30pm

- This level introduces children to the water with the parent.
- Enter and exit the water independently.
- Submerge face and blow bubbles.
- Walk in water and maintain balance. Bounce/ bob in chest deep water.
- Float with support. Kick with support (kick board). Practice basic alternating arm action.

SWIM BASICS 2:

Recommended for ages 6-10 years old

Class Times: 6:40pm-7:10pm & 7:20pm-7:50pm

- Children are familiar with the water and now need to develop skills.
- Hold breath and fully submerge for more than 5 seconds
- Submerge to retrieve objects in chest deep water.
- Explore deep water with floatation support.
- Perform flutter kick on front and back (support optional).and perform back crawl arm action.
- Turn over from front to back and back to front and float on back while finning with hands.
- Perform combined (kick & arms) stroke front, 5 yards and stroke back, 5 yards
- Jump into deep end water with floatation support.
