Need a little extra time in your day? We've got you covered! CHILL TIME is the perfect way for campers to start and end their day in a fun, relaxed setting at Gillam-Grant. Kids can kick back with friends, enjoy a snack, watch movies, play games, or just hang out and recharge. CHILL TIME runs from 7:00–9:00am and 3:00–6:00pm, giving families flexible options before and after camp. Campers will be safely escorted between camp and the Gillam-Grant Community Center by our staff.

The cost is \$38 per week for either before or after care—and you can sign up for both if you need a full day of coverage!
